School Age Care Grades K*-5

Child care provided by the Y is more than looking after kids. It's about nurturing their development by providing a safe place to learn and develop healthy, trusting relationships. In the Y School Age Care program, we incorporate Social and Emotional Learning (SEL) as an education process for helping kids develop fundamental life skills. SEL teaches kids to understand and manage emotions, set and achieve positive goals, feel and show empathy for others, establish and maintain positive relationships and make responsible decisions. That makes for confident kids today and contributing and engaged adults tomorrow.

Grades 1 - 5: Safety is our top priority. Parents/guardians sign their children into the program in the morning and students walk to class when school starts. In the afternoon, students walk from class to the School Age Care Program and parents/guardians must sign them out at pick up time.

*Y Kindergarten Care:

Care is available at Pike Lake and Snail Lake Education/Kindergarten Centers (KC) for students attending all-day Kindergarten. Students also have the option to attend the YMCA Before and After Care program at the elementary school in their attendance area. Students will be transported by bus between the attendance area school and Pike Lake and Snail Lake Education/Kindergarten Centers.

PROGRAM FEES

3 sessions: \$37.65

4 sessions: \$50.20

5 sessions: \$62.75

6 sessions: \$75.30

7 sessions: \$87.85

8 sessions: \$100.40

9 sessions: \$112.95

10 sessions: \$125.50

All schools will offer a full-morning care rate for \$12.55 per session. Valentine Hills, Pinewood, Island Lake and Turtle Lake Elementary schools will also offer a \$6.28 rate for parents that choose to drop off after 8:30 a.m. due to the later start time.

There is a 3-session minimum for the half-price option. If you are signed up for the half-price and full price options there is a 3-session minimum for each option (Your child must be registered for a total of 6 sessions per week). **Registration for half-price sessions are available online only.**

Afternoon care at all eight program locations will have one option of \$12.55 per afternoon session.

- A permanent School Age Care schedule is required at time of registration. You must register your child for at least 3 sessions per week for full session rate and/or 3 sessions per week for half session rate. You may combine Before and After care sessions to meet the minimum.
- You may add, remove or switch sessions to your child's weekly schedule. Changes must be made by Monday, one week prior to care.

FEES & BILLING

- A non-refundable fee of \$50 per child must accompany registration (unless you register within the promotional savings period). You may authorize weekly automatic electronic fund transfers (EFT) on your registration form.
- Session Fees are paid by EFT on Tuesday, the week prior to each week of care.
- Late payment fees are applied Saturday prior to session.

CHILD CARE ASSISTANCE PROGRAMS

For those families receiving assistance through the county or other agency, a current Authorization of Service must be on file with our Customer Service Center before fees may be billed to County/Third Party/Agency. Parent/guardian is responsible for full payment until an "Authorization of Service" is received. Include this information on your registration form.
