This list is required if you want to camp out in a tent or quinzhee huts. If not, all items may still come in handy but those marked with an asterisk (*) are optional.

Bedding– for overnights which are optional

_2nd set of long underwear and hat to wear at night*

- _Sleeping bag (camp has extras to double up for sleeping out)-all need for cabins
- _Sleeping pad*

- _Stuff bags and plastic bags
- _Toothbrush and toiletries
- _Water bottle
- _X-country ski equipment and snowshoes*
