

Summer registration at du Nord is handled through a Lottery process, giving all families an equal opportunity to register for a week of family camp. Online entry for the Lottery begins in September and has a deadline of November 27, 2019 and the Lottery Day will occur on December 7, 2019.

After Lottery Day, all cabin/sites remaining will be open for registration on a first-come, first-served basis beginning on January 16.

Additional Summer Programs Leadership Development Program

Teens entering grades 10 through their first summer out of high school may apply for the Leadership Development Program. LDP participants will learn about leadership through helping counselors facilitate camp programs and taking part in training sessions designed to help them grow as leaders and individuals. Applications are due Friday, January 17, 2020.

Resource Families

Each week, Camp du Nord has two Resource Families that help our family programs by running Polar Bear Swim each morning, assisting with dining hall set-up, and facilitating adult age group programming. Returning families looking for a service component to their camp experience are encouraged to apply. Knowledge of and experience with nearby hikes, paddles, and other outdoor programming is important. Applications are due Friday, November 15, 2019.

du Trips

The du Trips program provides opportunity for families to expand their wilderness experience. This 2–4 night experience begins and ends at du Nord. Spend time with your family and a trained staff member exploring the Boundary Waters Canoe Area Wilderness. Housing provided at camp for arrival and departure days.
