Family Camp weekends are the perfect introduction to the Boundary Waters Canoe Area Wilderness. Families spend the weekend hiking and canoeing to the many scenic spots in the area around Menogyn, observing wildlife and enjoying campfires.

Our skilled staff will travel with families on day-long or half day trips. Family trips could include taking a day to paddle to Rose Falls with a bag-lunch, or paddling then hiking to Caribou Rock or Honeymoon Bluff Palisades. President's Day and New Years winter weekend activities include dog sledding, skiing and snowshoeing, lounging in our lodge by the fire, building Quinzhees (snow huts), sledding, stargazing, or just simply listening to the absolute silence.

All activities focus on families being together and enjoying the wilderness.

Accommodations

Accommodations at Menogyn are rooms or cabins that hold 6 to 20 people. Most families share cabin space with another family. Our bathrooms are outdoor biffs. For participants with special needs, there are two rooms of six bunks with accessible indoor bathrooms available.

Menogyn is located on the wilderness side of West Bearskin Lake and in the summer is only accessible by boat and by foot in the winter. We'll pick you up in the pontoon in the summer and escort your family across the lake in the winter just give a call from the intercom in the Welcome Pavilion!

Your days will be filled with home-cooked Menogyn meals and a relaxing wood fired sauna on the last night. We guarantee intense peace and quiet.

\$170 per person 13 years of age and up.
\$90 per child 3-12 years
Children 3 and under are free.



*Cost includes lodging Friday night through Sunday night, meals and snacks Saturday morning through Monday morning and trained, caring Menogyn staff.
