MINNESOTA YMCA MODEL UNITED NATIONS INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE UND-1 FORM

The UND-1 form is the delegate assignment form for each country's group (grades 9 – 12). Every ambassador should consult his or her delegates and assign them to the indicated spots on each committee or organ. Complete this form and submit it in tandem with the country's online registrations.

The UND-1 is required before a country can be assigned and seated for the program.

Background to Delegate Assignments

- If a country has members on the Security Council, Historic Security Council, International Court of Justice, Human Rights Council (HRC) or Economic and Social Council (ECOSOC) those delegates will meet in their own organs for the entire Model United Nations Assembly.
- Delegates to the General Assembly must be assigned to General Assembly Committees. Assign members to separate General Assembly committees.

Step-by-Step Process to Complete UND-1

1. Consult country members for preferences on committee assignments.
2. If a country holds seats on the Security Council, Historic Security Council, International Court of Justice, Human Rights Council or the ECOSOC, **assign these delegates first.**
3. Assign all other delegates to a maximum of three of the six General Assembly committees.
(If you have one GA delegate, only assign to 1 committee. If you have two GA delegates, only assign to 2 committees. If you have three GA delegates, only assign to 3 committees.)
4. Once the UND-1 form is completed, copy it so that the ambassador and Delegation Director will have a record of the country's assignments. Submit the country's UND-1 at the time of registration. Remember that registrations will not be considered complete without both the country's UND-1 and online registrations for all the country group's delegates submitted.

Incomplete registrations cannot be processed!

Countries will not be assigned without the minimum number of delegates being registered.
